Charlevoix Township is pleased to announce, we have contracted Little Traverse Disposal to provide our community wide curbside trash clean up this year. Clean up will start May **6th, 2024**, and run through the week.

To maintain efficiency the following is being requested of our residents:

- Pick up is limited to RESIDENTIAL addresses only.
- Trash amount is limited to 2 cubic yards per address.
 - 3 feet high x 3 feet wide x 6 feet long or
 - Size of standard pickup truck to the top of the bed rails
- Smaller items should be placed in a container, if you wish to keep the container please write "SAVE" on the outside of the container.
- Items should be placed on curbside, not in the road or ditches by **Monday May 6th at 6:00am** and only **"ONE"** stop per home.
- Please separate metal items from other trash or rubbish.
- Please keep the weight of all containers to a safe lifting capacity.
- Piles of construction debris must be placed in containers.

Items not accepted during clean up:

Paint cans unless paint is dried, and the lid is off the container. Paint mixed with absorbent can be taken.

- Windows larger than 5 feet in any direction.
- Chemicals
- Yard Debris or Brush
- Burn Barrels with Ashes Inside
- Bulk Liquids (Fryer Grease, Oils, Solvents)
- Tires will only be accepted if they are cut in half.
- All Freon Appliances MUST HAVE FREON REMOVED AND CERTIFIED TAGGED
- Concrete- No large pieces and rubble needs to be in a container that can be lifted safely.
